It has not gone to the lobbyist because of the new DNA law that was presented. The statute has been changed, deleted and rewritten and has gone from four pages to 1 ½ pages.

1. Dollar amounts have been changed from \$25.00 to 150.00
2. Holding safekeeping and found property from 60 to 90 days to 30 days.
3. Money and all other property will remain the same.
4. Easier to read
